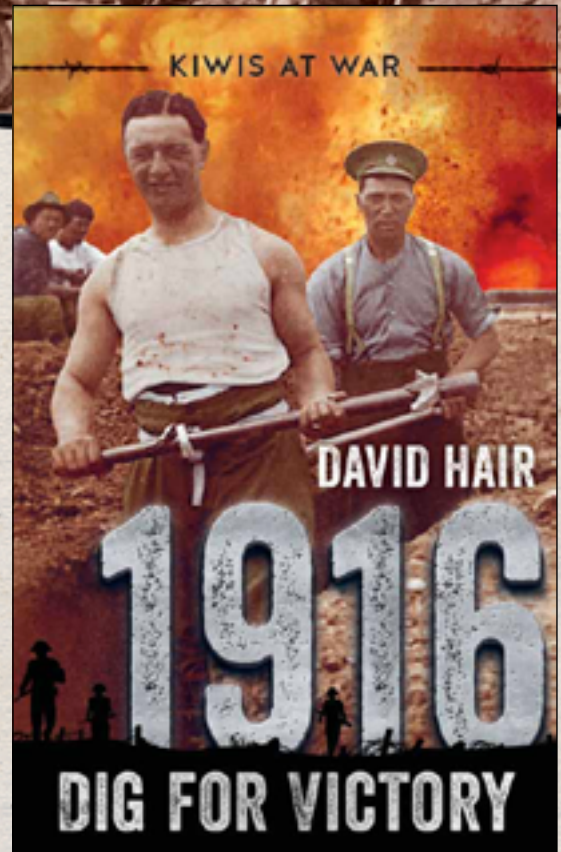
Once they fought against each other for the land, now they fight together to protect it.
