

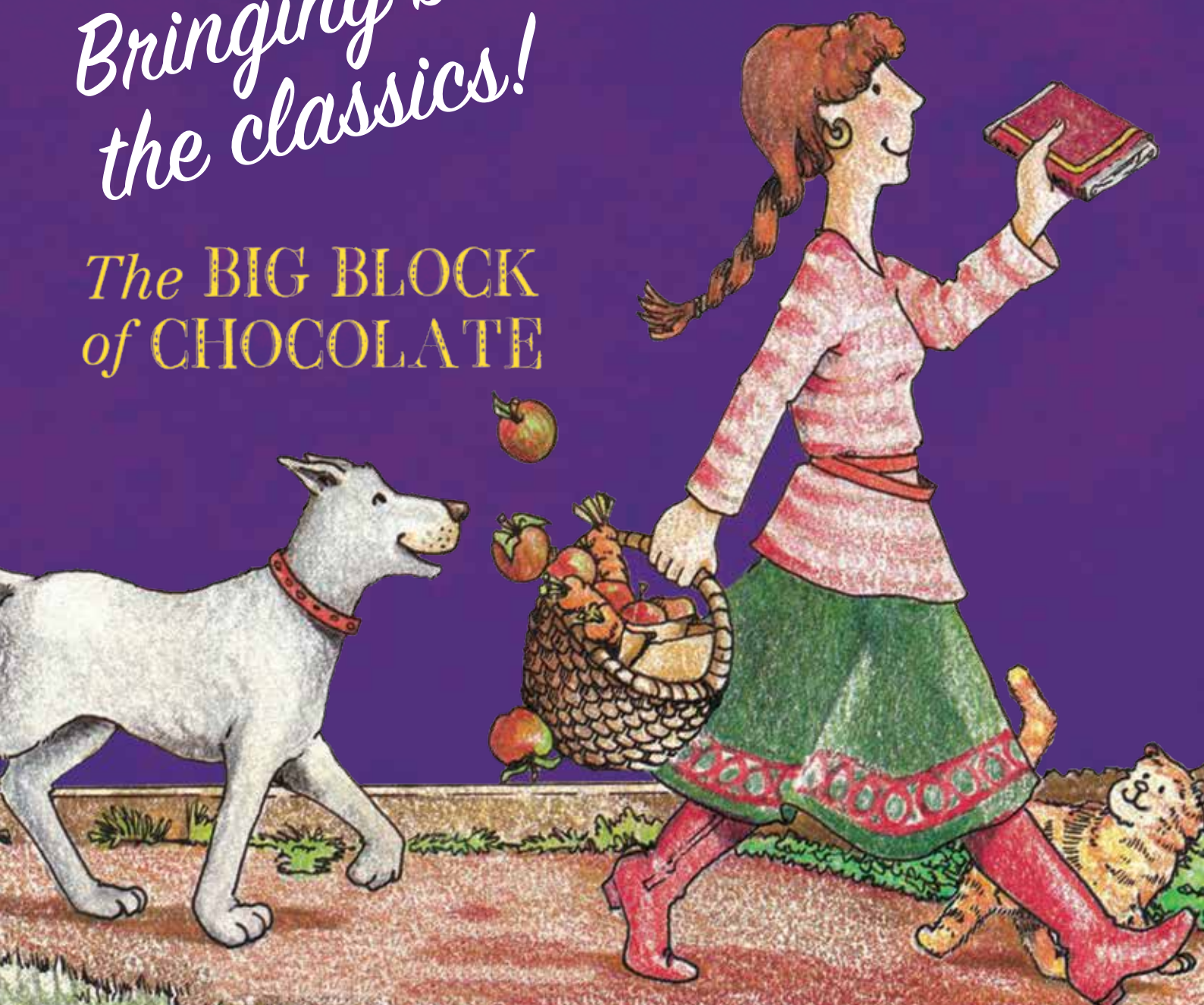

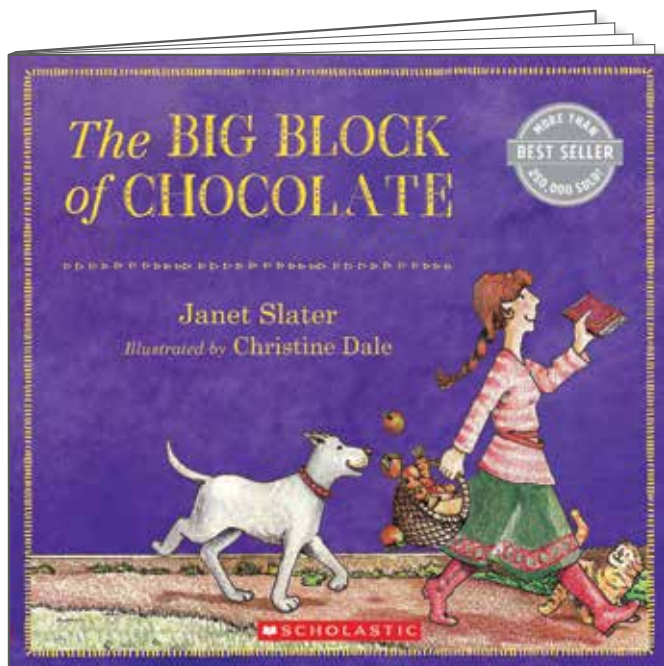

Many of her children's and adult stories have been adapted for radio, and some for television. Now semi-retired, she is still addicted to writing.

CHRISTINE DALE illustrated the much-loved original *The Big Block of Chocolate* in the mid-1980s while she was employed as Assistant Editor at Scholastic New Zealand. Christine went on to become Publishing Manager before she retired from publishing 25 years later.
