

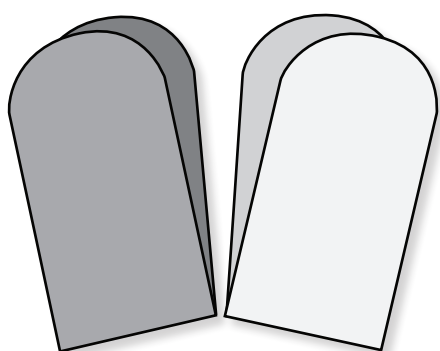
Christmas in Norway

The *julekurv* is a Norwegian Christmas basket usually made from straw or high-gloss paper which Norwegians fill with sweets and hang on their Christmas trees.

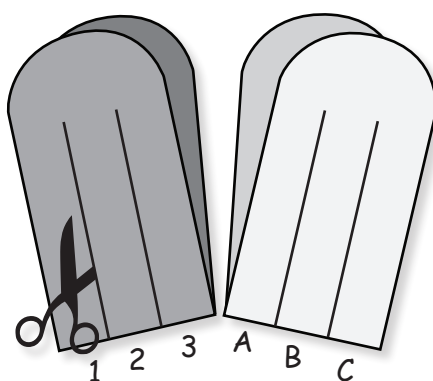
What you need

- Strip of rectangular red paper
- Strip of rectangular green paper
- Scissors
- Patience!

What to do

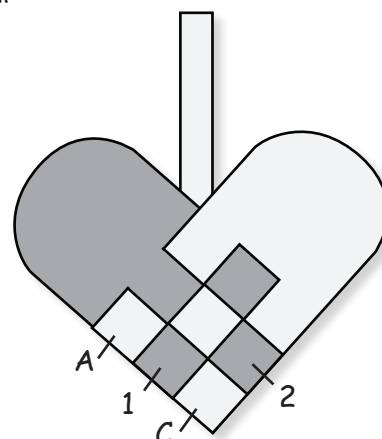
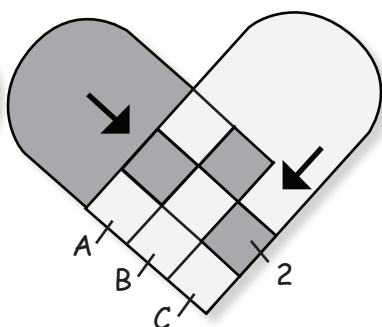
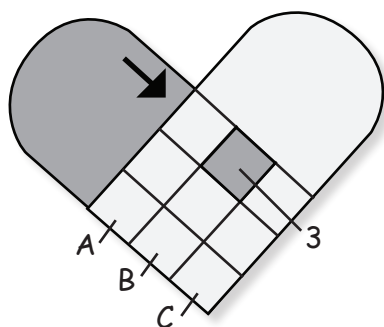


1. Fold each of the pieces of coloured paper in half and use the template to cut out the pattern.



2. Still using the template, cut two lines from the bottom of the fold, making sure you don't cut all the way through!

3. To make weaving easier label each strip on the green side 1, 2 and 3 and label each strip on the red side A, B, and C. Use a pencil.



4. **First row:** Place A inside 3; 2 inside A; then A inside 1
Second row: Place 3 inside B; B inside 2; then 1 inside B
Third row: Place C inside 3; 2 inside C; then C inside 1

Don't worry if you don't get it the first time. Be patient and take things slowly!

5. Attach a handle using leftover pieces of coloured paper.

6. Hang the finished baskets around the classroom!
