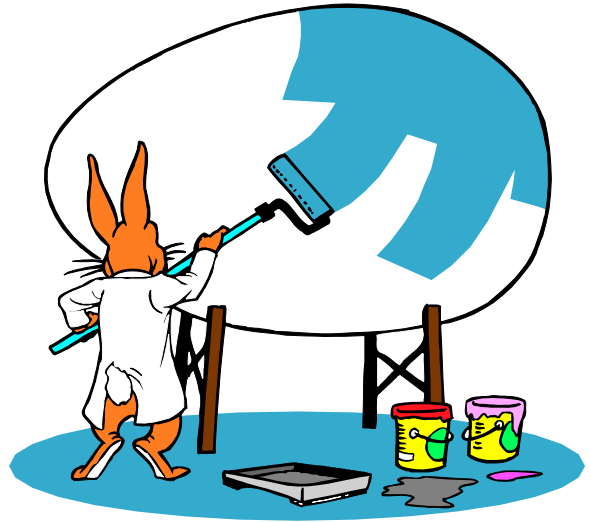
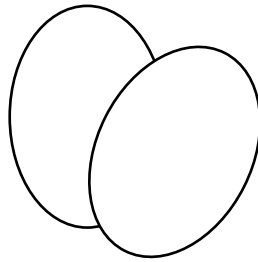


HOW TO MAKE YOUR OWN DECORATIVE EASTER EGGS:



What you'll need:

1. 1 or 2 hard boiled eggs.
2. Coloured food dye.
3. A mixing bowl.
4. An egg carton.



Instructions:

- Add water and your favourite coloured food dye to the mixing bowl.
- Place your hard-boiled egg in the mixing bowl. The longer you leave the egg in the bowl the darker the colour will be. Remove the eggs using a large spoon.
- Let the eggs dry on upside-down egg cartons.
- Now decorate the eggs any way you please, using glitter, textas and other add-ons.

THINGS TO TRY!!!!

- Paint or draw faces on your eggs before you put them in the dye.
- Try using two different-coloured dyes and dye each end of the egg a different colour.
- Use sequins, stickers, lace and ribbon to make your egg unique.
- Make a MURAL out of your egg. You could decorate your egg using a space theme and create a cardboard backdrop; or make your egg a little doll, giving it a face and making it a cot out of an old margarine container.
- Finally you could make a tree of eggs in your classroom, using an old branch. Everyone can bring in their decorated egg and hang it from the branch.
