

# Paws for Books Top Dog Challenge Instructions



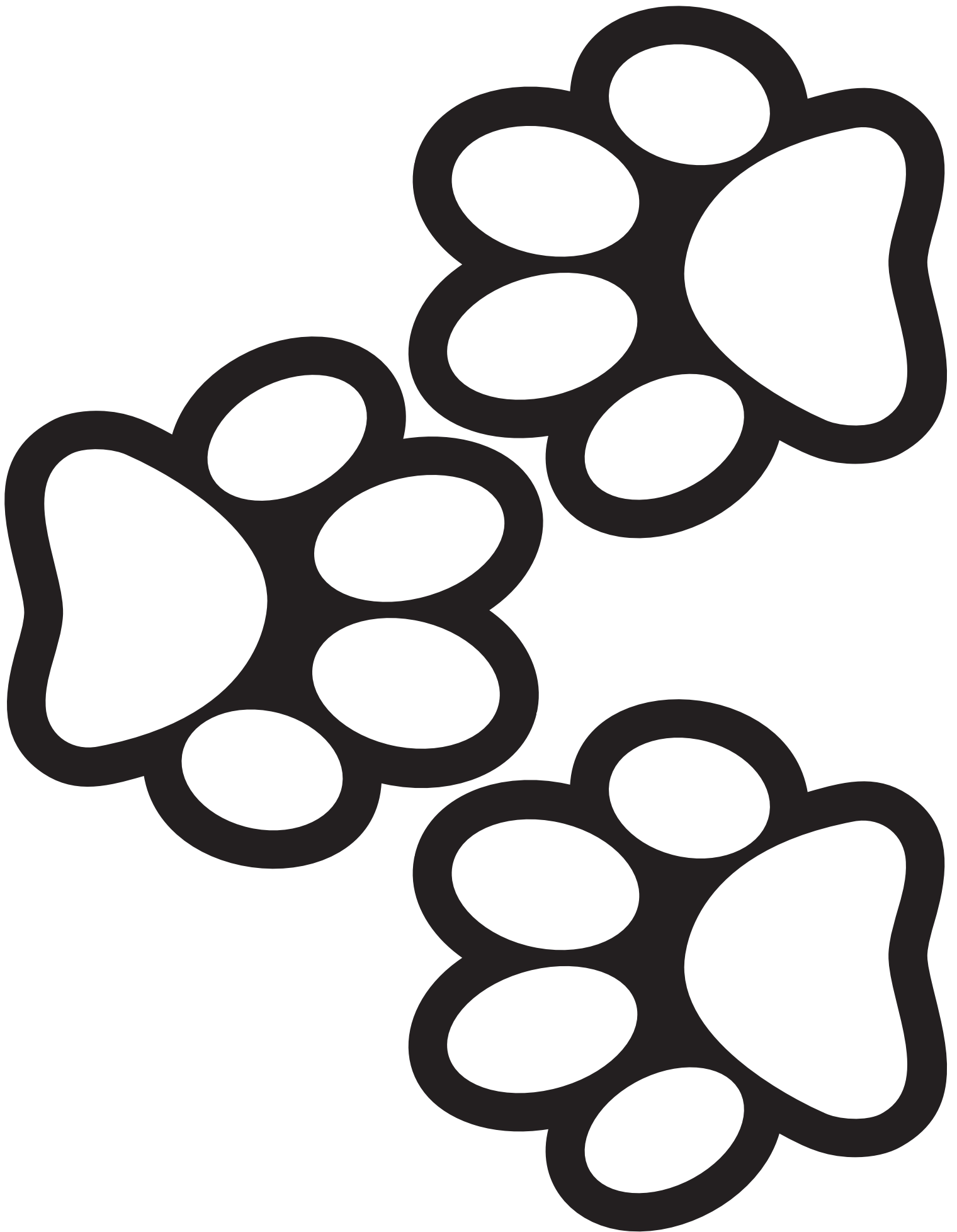
## Supplies\*:

- 2 liter bottles
- Large construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Utility knife
- Printer
- Color printer paper
- Markers
- Poster board

## Directions:

1. Cut a slit into the top of a clean 2 liter bottle with a utility knife *(For safety purposes, we recommend wearing leather gloves when using the blade. Never leave the blade where children can pick it up.)*
2. Wrap construction paper around the 2 liter bottle and glue/tape in place.
3. Cut out dog and cat ears from construction paper and glue/tape them to the top of the 2 liter bottle.
4. Print and cut out the paw prints on page 2 on different colors of printer paper. Write the classroom grade on the paw print label and glue to construction paper covered 2 liter bottle.
5. Have the students decorate the body and ears of the bottles with markers.
6. Use the template on page 3 to fill in the names of the winning classrooms.
7. Tile print the template from page 3 and glue it to a poster board.

\*Remember, these are only suggestions. This project should be fun and creative, so use supplies you have on hand for substitutions.
