

# Twig Crown



## Supplies\*:

- Bunch of 8"-10" tall twigs
- Tape measure
- Approx. 24" x 4" strip of canvas fabric
- Scissors
- Hot glue gun and glue sticks
- 1" ribbon

## Directions:

1. Trim any excess length from twigs and remove any smaller branches or leaves.
2. Measure the circumference of the child's head (usually around 20"-24"). Cut the canvas fabric to that length by 4" wide.
3. Lay out the canvas fabric strip. Apply hot glue to the top 2" of the strip and line up the twigs within the glued area, covering the length of the canvas fabric strip. **KEEP THE BOTTOM 2" OF CANVAS STRIP FREE OF TWIGS.**
4. Fold the bottom of the canvas fabric strip up, encasing the newly glued twigs. Glue the canvas fabric strip in place.
5. Glue a 1" ribbon to the length of the canvas fabric strip, extending an extra 5" of ribbon from both ends of the strip. Allow to dry.
6. Wrap the twig crown around the child's head and tie it in place with the ribbon.

\*Remember, these are only suggestions. This project should be fun and creative, so use supplies you have on hand for substitutions.
