

Book Fairy Costume



Supplies*:

- 150 photocopies of book pages
- Glue
- Hole punch
- 1" ribbon
- Stapler
- 4 small binder clips
- Printer
- Book cover template
- White multipurpose printer paper
- Scissors
- Cardboard
- Pencil
- Hot glue gun and glue sticks
- Nametag magnet

Directions:

For skirt:

1. Roll 100-120 photocopies diagonally into cones and glue to secure.
2. Punch a hole in the small ends of each cone.
3. Thread ribbon through the cones, continuing until it forms a skirt that can go around Book Fairy's waist. Tie the ribbon in a bow at the back.

For wings:

1. Accordion fold four photocopies, two widthwise and two lengthwise.
2. Layer one widthwise photocopy onto a lengthwise photocopy. Line the bottom of each of the copies up and staple, creating a fan.
3. Repeat Step 2 with the other two folded copies.
4. Use glue and two small binder clips to connect the ends of each of the fans.
5. Print out book cover template on pg. 3 onto white paper and cut out. Cover a 4" x 6" piece of cardboard with it.
6. Cut ½" strips out of a photocopy. Roll strips around a pencil, creating curls.
7. Glue curls to bottom of the 4" x 6" book cover.
8. Hot glue the book cover to the binder clip on side of the wings with text.
9. Hot glue a magnet to the other side of the wings.

For shoe clips:

1. Cut 10½" strips out of a photocopy.
2. Roll the strips around a pencil, creating curls.
3. Glue five of the strips together and hot glue to a binder clip.
4. Repeat Step 3 with the other curls.

*Remember, these are only suggestions.
This project should be fun and creative, so use
supplies you have on hand for substitutions.
