

Tissue Core Owl



Supplies*:

- Toilet paper core
- Paint brush
- White paint
- Grey and yellow construction paper
- Scissors
- Circle punch (optional)
- Hot glue gun and glue sticks
- Large googly eyes
- Brown feathers

Directions:

1. Paint the toilet paper core white. Allow to dry.
2. Push the sides of the core inward to form two points on the top, creating the owl ears.
3. Cut two grey circles out of construction paper (or use a circle punch to punch out.) Hot glue the circles to the painted toilet paper roll.
4. Hot glue large googly eyes to the center of the grey circles.
5. Cut a triangular beak out of yellow construction paper. Hot glue the beak beneath the eyes.
6. Glue a cluster of feathers to each side of the owl.

*Remember, these are only suggestions. This project should be fun and creative, so use supplies you have on hand for substitutions.
