

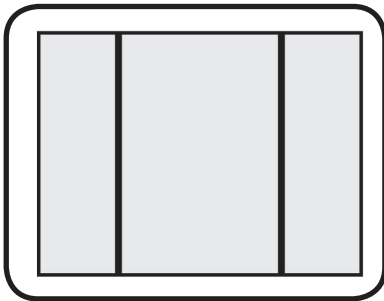
Fairy Ring Toss



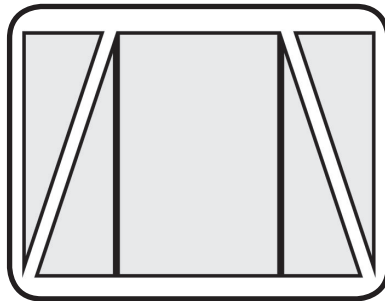
Supplies*:

- White tri-fold board
- Utility knife
- Meter stick
- Cardboard
- Masking tape
- Paint brushes
- Green, red, pink, orange, maroon, and white paint
- Small paper bowls
- Scissors
- Hot glue gun and glue sticks
- White foam cups
- White paper plates

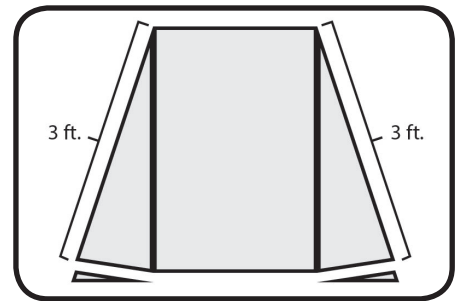
Directions:



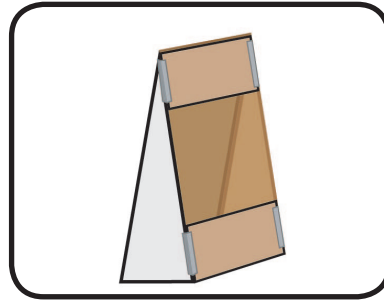
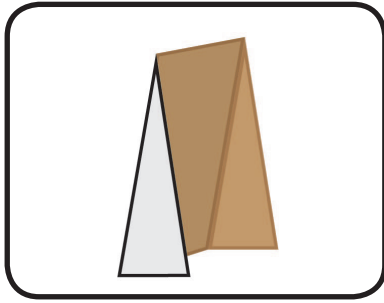
1. Lay the tri-fold board flat



2. Cut both flaps in half diagonally with a utility knife. (For safety purposes, we recommend wearing leather gloves when using the utility knife. Never leave the utility knife where children can pick it up.)



3. Measure 3' down from the top on both sides. Cut off the remainder of the flap.



4. Fold the side panels back.
5. Cut two 2' wide rectangles out of cardboard. Tape both ends to the two triangles, creating an A-frame. Stand it upright.
6. Paint the A-frame green. Allow to dry.
7. Cut the bottoms off of 8 small paper bowls.
8. Hot glue the paper bowl bottoms to the bottoms of foam cups, forming 8 toadstools.
9. Paint the toadstool tops red, pink, orange, and maroon. Allow to dry. Paint white spots on toadstool tops.
10. Hot glue the toadstools to the green A-frame, like shown.
11. Cut the centers out of large paper plates, creating the rings.

*Remember, these are only suggestions. This project should be fun and creative, so use supplies you have on hand for substitutions.
