

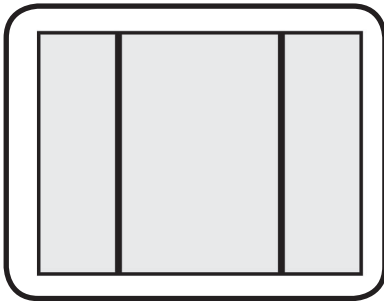
Owl Bean Bag Toss



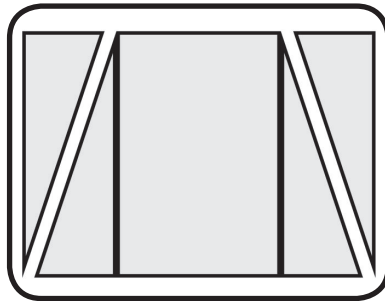
Supplies*:

- White tri-fold board
- Utility knife
- Meter stick
- Masking tape
- Paint brushes
- Paint (blue, white, yellow, and black)
- Beanbags

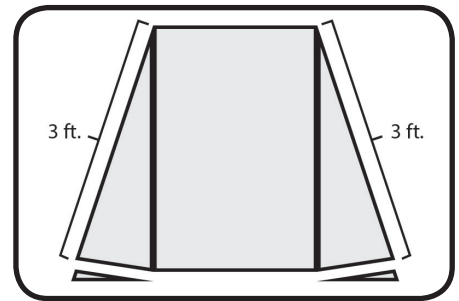
Directions:



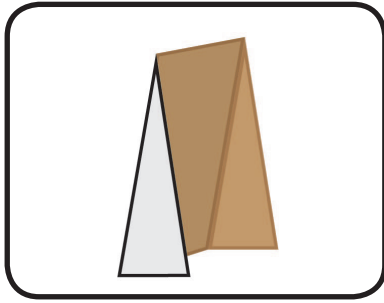
1. Lay the tri-fold board flat



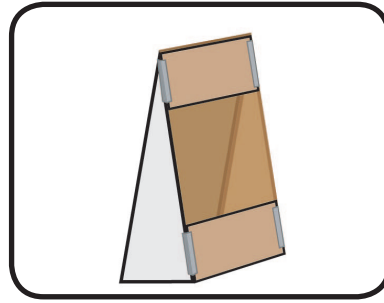
2. Cut both flaps in half diagonally with a utility knife. (For safety purposes, we recommend wearing leather gloves when using the utility knife. Never leave the utility knife where children can pick it up.)



3. Measure 3' down from the top on both sides. Cut off the remainder of the flap.



4. Fold the side panels back.



5. Cut two 2' wide rectangles out of cardboard. Tape both ends to the two triangles, creating an A-frame. Stand it upright.

6. Paint an owl and blue background on the A-frame.

7. Cut out beanbag holes with a utility knife.
