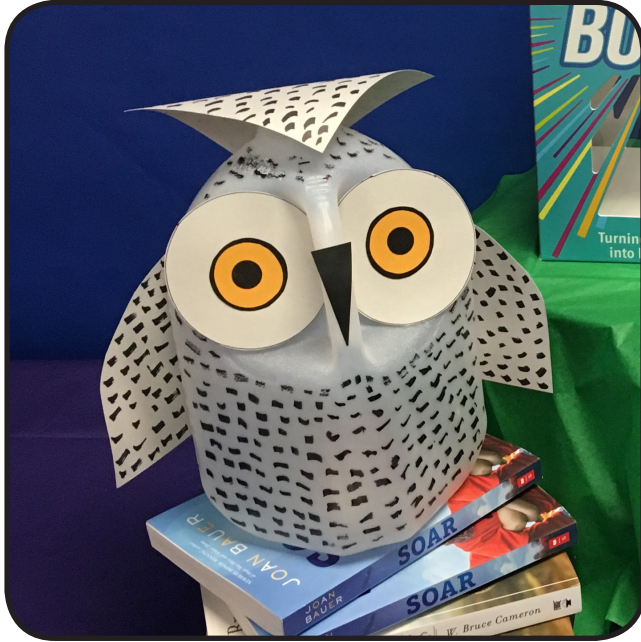


Owl Milk Jug



Supplies*:

- Gallon milk jug
- Black, gray, and dark yellow cardstock
- Scissors
- Black permanent marker
- Hot glue gun and glue sticks
- Pattern

Directions:

1. Remove the label from a clean gallon milk jug.
2. Cut a 5" square out of gray cardstock for top of owl's head. Create feathers with a black permanent marker, like shown.
3. Cut two large gray circles out of cardstock, two medium-sized circles out of black cardstock, two medium-sized circles out of dark yellow cardstock, and two small circles out of black cardstock. Hot glue together, like shown.
4. Cut a beak out of black cardstock.
5. Cut two wings out of gray cardstock, making sure you have a right and left wing. Add small feathers to the wings with black permanent marker.
6. Create feathers with black permanent marker on the two sides of the jug, under the handle.
7. Hot glue eyes behind the handle.
8. Hot glue the beak to the handle.
9. Attach wings to the sides of jug, like shown.
10. Hot glue around the top edge of mouth of jug and attach the 5" gray square, making sure to extend one corner over the top of the jug and letting it hang down a little in the front. Hot glue back corner down.

*Remember, these are only suggestions. This project should be fun and creative, so use supplies you have on hand for substitutions.
