

Unicorn Milk Jug



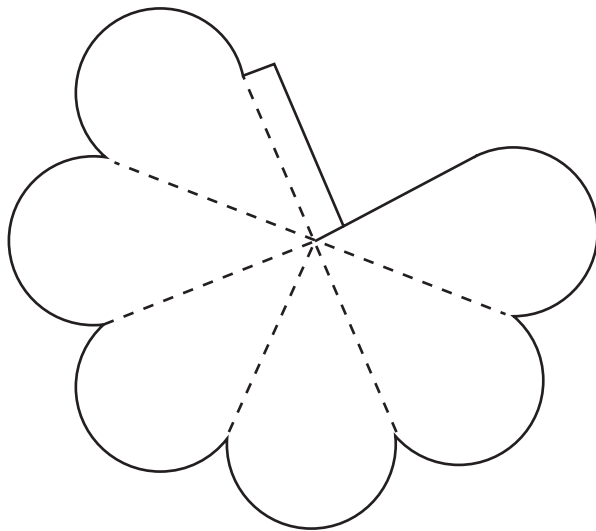
Supplies*:

- Gallon milk jug
- White, pink, and gold cardstock
- Scissors
- Transparent tape
- ¼" gold ribbon
- Hot glue gun and glue sticks
- Glue
- Assorted colors of cardstock
- Gold permanent marker
- Pencil
- Assorted colors of curling ribbon (or 2 premade ribbon package decorations)
- Pattern

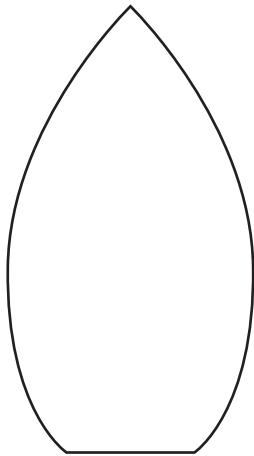
Directions:

1. Remove the label from a clean gallon milk jug.
2. Roll an approximate 7" square of white cardstock into a cone shape and tape edge, creating a unicorn horn.
3. Hot glue one end of gold ribbon to top of cone. Wind gold ribbon around and down to the bottom edge and hot glue in place.
4. Hot glue around the hole on top of milk jug and attach cone, tipping slightly to front, at an angle.
5. Cut two outer ear pieces out of white cardstock and two inner ear pieces out of pink cardstock. Glue inner ear pieces to outer ear pieces, but not below fold line. Fold bottoms of ear pieces forward and hot glue on each side of the unicorn horn.
6. Cut about eight flowers out of the assorted color cardstock. Fold on lines.
7. Draw lines inside the flowers using a gold permanent marker.
8. Fold flowers and hot glue, making sure tab is in back of the flower. Hot glue flowers around horn and ears, like shown.
9. Cut two eyelashes out of gold cardstock. Curl around a pencil. Hot glue to milk jug.
10. Cut the nostrils and mouth piece out of brown and pink cardstock respectively. Hot glue to milk jug.
11. Hot glue assorted color curling ribbon pieces or premade pieces to milk jug handle, creating unicorn mane.

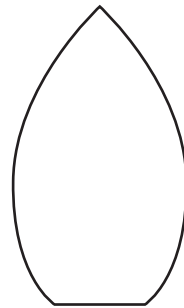
*Remember, these are only suggestions. This project should be fun and creative, so use supplies you have on hand for substitutions.

(Flower)



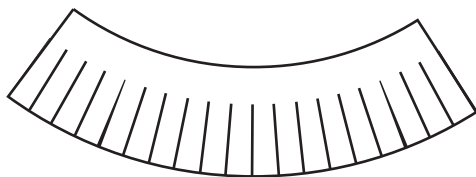
Cut 2
