

BOOK ROCKET TABLE DISPLAY

MAKES
A GREAT
ACTIVITY FOR
STUDENTS



Supplies*:

- Recycled plastic bottles
- Paper towel tubes
- Glitter foam sheets
- Spray paint
- Coloured paper
- Silver bubble wrap (*found at a hardware store*)
- Glitter foam shapes
- Metallic gift wrap tinsel
- Any household craft items
- Printed out or hand-drawn book characters and logos
- Markers
- Tape
- Scissors
- Glue

Directions:

1. Paint a paper towel tube or plastic bottle, or cover with coloured paper.
2. Create a rocket nose cone from paper or glitter foam and tape to the top of the tube or bottle.
3. Embellish the rocket with glitter stars, markers, glitter glue, sparkle tape, etc. Add on handmade or copied artwork from a favorite book or series.
4. Glue on rocket wings. To add rocket fire, glue gift wrap tinsel to the bottom of the rocket.

**Remember, these are only suggestions. These decorations should be fun and creative, so use whatever supplies you have on-hand for substitutions.*
